Dear Students, Parents, Guardians and Caregivers,

Most pressing on the minds of all of us has been the acts of violence that occurred outside the school and that have been posted all over social media this week. It breaks my heart to see what has happened and that it had found its way into our school. The lockdown on Wednesday was called under the direction of 911 in an abundance of caution when a staff member spotted students in the parking lot with what appeared to be weapons. The lockdown went quickly and smoothly and Calgary Police were on site within minutes. We communicated to families throughout this process (first when the lockdown occurred and once it concluded after CPS conducted their search). The videos and the lockdown were alarming and distressing for our staff and students. It does erode feelings of safety. The next day I addressed the entire school about the recent events. I shared that we arranged SRO support, 3 officers for the entire day. We also opened Students Services to any students who felt anxious or wanted to talk and requested staff to refer any students they felt were stressed. We also brought in 2 guest teachers to support our staff should they require time or support. The day was quiet and the SROs reported that the vibe in the school was a good one. We will continue to remain vigilant with supervision and keep the school secure. Please remind your child to always wear their school ID before leaving for school. This is a vital part of our safety measures. It helps us identify intruders right away. I want to thank students, staff and Calgary Police for handling this situation in a prompt and responsible manner. Should you have any further questions please contact me at school.


Although the negatives this week was serious I always remind myself of the vast amount of positives that fill each and everyday.


