

Lester B. Pearson Newsletter - October 13, 2024


Dear Students, Parents, Guardians and Caregivers,

PE 30 Kayaking Class appreciating a perfect day on the water.










It looks like a culinary class, but it is the first meeting of the Cake Club. They worked on icing and piping. Stay tuned for a Halloween Bake Sale!!!
