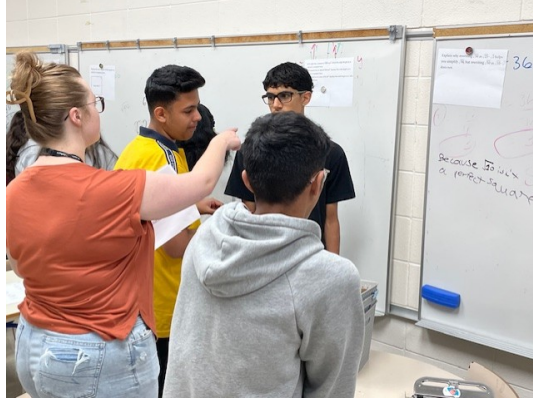
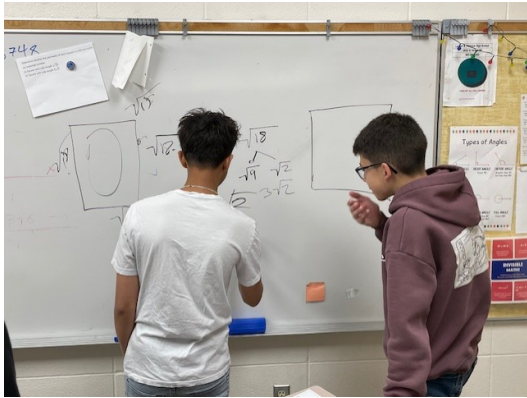

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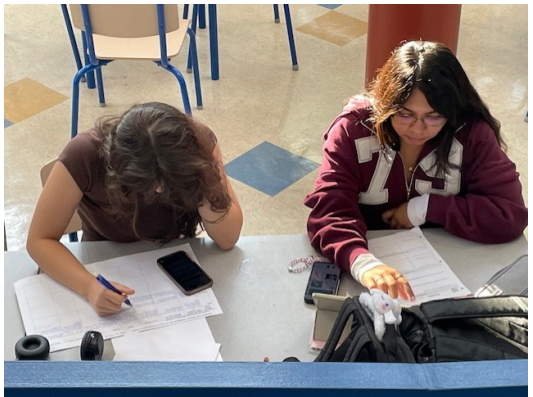
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Enjoyed a visit to Ms. Taylor's math class. Vertical math review and everyone gets a chance to solve the questions. The best way to learn is to talk about what you know.

Pearson's Snack Shack is open for business. Always love seeing students doing their homework during their spare.

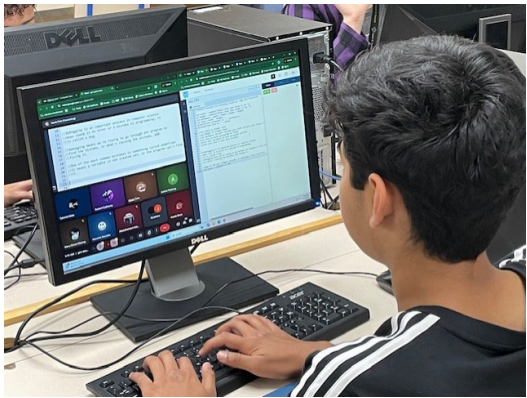

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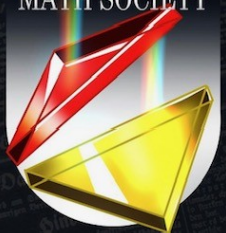
