Ella's Capstone Project 2025, a mural for the dance studio. Spectacular!!!



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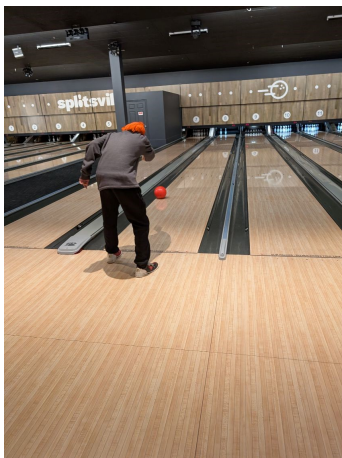
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ACCESS enjoying time in culinary. No better way to relax from assessments than to hit the mats for the wrestling team.
