Please accept this attached scholarship application form on behalf of the Calgary Calabrian Cultural and Heritage Society. This society is a non-profit organization established in 1985 for the purpose of promoting the heritage and culture of Calabrians and their descendants and to assist others within the community of Calgary. The association awards scholarships annually to high school students who have excelled academically and demonstrate strong citizenship. Specifically, two scholarships valued at a minimum of \$2000.00 each will be awarded to two such students each year at the annual banquet. The **criteria** for choosing candidates are as follows:

- 1. The applicant must be of Calabrian descent (someone on the mother's side or the father's side of the applicant must have originally been from the region of Calabria, Italy. This includes parents, grandparents, great grandparents, etc.).
- 2. The applicant must have completed high school (Grade 12) in the school year 2019- 2020. Please note that students who graduated in the previous school year and upgraded during the 2019-20 school year are ineligible.
- 3. The applicant must have attended high school in Calgary or surrounding areas.
- 4. The applicant must enroll in a post-secondary institution within one year. (proof of registration must be shown before awarding of scholarship)
- 5. The applicant must maintain good academic standing.
- 6. The applicant is an exemplary citizen.
- 7. The applicant must attend the annual banquet on January 30, 2021 and deliver a short speech if selected as the successful candidate. In the event that the banquet is cancelled due to COVID 19, recipients will be acknowledged at a future banquet.
