Student Exam Information

- ▶ Review the rules and procedures for diploma exams, the exam schedule (dates and times) this is all posted on the school website.
- ▶ Remind students to BE EARLY!
- Let students know that the diploma results will be available through myPass.
- Make sure students know they need to bring HB pencils, eraser, a black or blue pen and their school ID (or other photo ID such as a driver's license)
- For students writing exams using a calculator make sure they know what is APPROVED and that they ensure they have good batteries (or bring extras)



Student Exam Information

- ▶ Remind students that they may bring snacks but they have to be in a clear plastic bag (please remove wrappers) and they may have water in a clear plastic bottle with no labels -NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Remind students that they are NOT to bring any bags, backpacks notes or books to the exam. All coats, jackets and hats must go in lockers, NO cell phones or other digital devices will be allowed in the exam room – leave them at home or in a locker!
- ▶ All school-based exams will follow the same rules and procedures as for diploma exams.
- ▶ On the final day of classes teachers and students will be asked to help with moving classroom desks and chairs to the gymnasiums. Specific information will be provided the week before exams.



Where to write?

- For part A written of ELA and Social Diplomas we will be written using computer technology (Vretta).
- ▶ Most of the exams will be written in the Main and Aux gymnasiums with the exception of Physics 30, Science 30, which will be written in 2167. Science 20, ELA and Social 10 and 20 level exams will be written during regular class time.
- ► Exam schedules and student writing locations will be posted at the front of the school each exam day.
